The Del Mar Planning Commission serves as the official planning body of the City of Del Mar. The Planning Commission is responsible for the initial review and recommendation to the City Council on all proposed changes to the Del Mar Community Plan, the City's Zoning Code and for reviewing and approving all Variances, Special Use permits, Coastal Zone permits, and all filings under the Subdivision Map Act within the City of Del Mar. The Del Mar Design Review Board (DRB) is charged with responsibility for enforcing Del Mar's Design Review Ordinance (Chapter 23.08 of the Del Mar Municipal Code). The Design Review Ordinance is intended to protect the residential, seaside character of the community by fostering and encouraging good design, the use of harmonious materials and colors, compatible proportional relationships of buildings and appropriate landscaping on all new construction and building modifications within the community, in keeping with the goals and policies of the Del Mar Community Plan. The seven (7) members of the DRB are appointed by the City Council to overlapping four (4) year terms. The DRB meets regularly on the fourth Wednesday of each month at 6:00 PM.
